Services described below are for students who are:

- At least 14 years old
- Current IEP or 504 Plan (Public, private, or home-schooled)
- Who are potentially eligible for services because of a disability
- Who have a need for services



Why do we need Pre-ETS?

- Individuals with disabilities are unemployed at a higher rate than any other demographic
- Pre-ets can prepare you for a lifetime of successful employment
- Hands on learning in real situations makes your classroom work come alive
- High school is a great time to learn how to get a job, keep a job, become a confident worker and make an educated decision about pursuing higher education or advanced training



What are Pre-ETS?

Pre-ETS are 5 career focused services:

1. Job Exploration Counseling — Discuss career options and learn about in-demand jobs
2. Work-Based Learning — Engaging in work experiences and learning about the workplace
3. Work Place Readiness — Improve social and independent living skills
4. Self-Advocacy — Learn skills for greater independence
5. Post-Secondary Counseling & Enrollment Assistance — Exploring options for education and training after high school graduation
